Today, 19 school districts and over 40 cities in Los Angeles and Ventura Counties lean into Villa for help dealing with the myriad of issues around having a loved one with an intellectual or developmental disability.

Since inception, Villa has been one of the leading advocates for people with I/DD in Los Angeles County - helping thousands of people of all ages manage adversity and challenges. Villa is the only agency in the San Gabriel Valley offering a continuum of care for individuals with I/DD of all ages, with a full range of programs serving children, adults, and seniors.

Villa Esperanza Services Programs for Adults and Seniors



Adult Day Program

- Assists those with intellectual/developmental and physical challenges, including age-related frailty
- Maintains an individual's independence and decreases social isolation
- Provides day respite for caregivers
- Helps participants stay mentally and physically active
- Provides Licensed Vocational Nurses to help meet the medical needs of participants

Dimensions Day Program

- For young adults or those that are retired from a work program
- Develops and maintains an individual's functional, cognitive, and behavioral skills required for successful integration in the community
- Offers pre-employment training through volunteer work in the community

Community Integration Program

- Pre-employment skills training through volunteerism
- Community-based
- Mobility training
- Self care and advocacy skill building

Employment Services

- Provides an inclusive, community-based employment and work placement program
- Assists with job skills such as resume writing, interview practice, goal setting, and more
- Matches work desires and career goals of participants to community employers
- Provides job coaching to foster employment stability

Independent Living Skills & Supported Living Services

- Provides support for individuals seeking to maintain a self-sustaining, independent living environment in the community
- Areas of support include money management, cooking, social skills, community resources, health and safety and more

Residential Program

- Provides various levels of support in seven group homes in Pasadena
- Provides quality living with an active lifestyle in their community
- Six independent living apartments in Pasadena
